

Student Engagement and Expectations

What will happen if those expectations are not met?

In-Person Academic School Support (IPASS) and In-School Suspension (ISS)- We will be bringing students who fail to engage, struggle with content, or misbehave while on line into school on Wednesdays.

It is important to note that students receiving ISS will have a log entry made on their behavioral record. No entry will be made for students who are asked to report to school for IPASS.

In both situations, masks and social distancing will be required and we will place no more than three students in one room. Transportation will be provided.

Steps that will be taken if the following occur;

If students are missing assignments

- Academic Probation/Loss of Credit/IPASS
Wednesdays

If there is non engagement/poor attendance

- 2 contact attempts by teachers
- Contact attempt by support staff
- Administration Contact (referral to IPASS Wednesdays)
- Well visit/home visit (support staff/ admin)
- DCF Report

Academic Probation

The academic probation procedure is outlined below:

- Teachers report students missing assignments on a daily basis by 1:45 P.M.
- An EMail, through powerschool, will be sent to student and parent/guardian daily.
- If the student is on the Academic Probation list for more than 5 days for the same assignment (without making-up assignment or setting a time to make-up assignment), the teacher will initiate “Loss of Credit Procedure”
- Loss of credit EMail from administration sent to student, parent/guardian
- Student may be referred to IPASS Wednesdays
- Attend Academic Appeals / Summer School for credit retrieval
