HENRY L. AND NELLIE E. BLAKESLEE SCHOLARSHIP FUND (Thomaston Resident *and* College Students)

Qualifications: Awarded to *Thomaston residents* who are **graduating from high school as well as students already attending college**. The winners of this scholarship are decided based on the criteria of financial need and academic standing.

Transcript and Essay Required: Essay should include your background, your interest in the academic program you have chosen, short and long range career plans, and why you are deserving of this scholarship.

THOMASTON ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP (Thomaston Resident *and* College students)

Scholarship money totaling \$10,000 will be awarded to **high school seniors as well as former students attending college who reside in Thomaston**. The scholarship winners will be selected on the basis of need, scholarship, and citizenship.

Transcript, Resume, and Essay required: "Share any personal information or circumstances that would lend greater insight into why you should be considered for this scholarship."
