Carefully read the description of each scholarship. Check the box corresponding to the scholarship (s) for which you meet the application criteria and wish to apply. This is a Common Scholarship Application Form; therefore, you need to fill out one completed form. **Please make copies of the form for each scholarship you are applying to. Transcripts from your high school and all other required documentation, such as letter of recommendation, resumes, or essays must accompany each application. Please be sure to include the name of the scholarship on each attachment.**

AMERICAN LEGION POST #22 SCHOLARSHIP

Qualifications: Awarded to Thomaston residents who are graduating from high school and who reside in Thomaston and plan to attend a two or four-year college/university in the fall. Candidate must have a GPA minimum of 3.50.

Required: Transcript and a one-page essay outlining your occupational goals and career path to achieve your objectives.

HENRY L. AND NELLIE E. BLAKESLEE SCHOLARSHIP FUND (Thomaston Resident *and* College Students)

Qualifications: Awarded to ***Thomaston residents*** who are **graduating from high school as well as students already attending college**. The winners of this scholarship are decided based on the criteria of financial need and academic standing.

Transcript and Essay Required: Essay should include your background, your interest in the academic program you have chosen, short and long range career plans, and why you are deserving of this scholarship.

FINE ARTS CONNECTION OF THOMASTON SCHOLARSHIP

Qualifications: This scholarship is awarded to graduating senior who is ***a Thomaston Resident*** and **excels in the arts** and plans to attend a college or university program in **any arts field** in the fall.

Transcript and Essay Required: "Explain the Importance of An Art Form In Your Life."

THOMASTON DEMOCRATIC TOWN COMMITTEE SCHOLARSHIP IN HONOR OF WILLIAM GLOADE

Qualifications: Awarded to a graduating senior who is **a Thomaston resident** who plans to study Political Science, Communications, Economics, Criminal Justice, or a student who demonstrates strong activism within the school community and/or broader community.

Transcript and Essay Required: "The reason why you should be awarded this scholarship"

JRC TRANSPORTATION INC. SCHOLARSHIP

Qualifications: Awarded to a **Thomaston Resident** graduating from high school. Student does not need to be in the top of the class. Consideration will be given to a candidate who has good attendance, is well-rounded, involved in extra-curricular activities, and is a community leader.

Transcript, Resume, Letter of Recommendation Essay Required: "The Impact I Want To Make On the World".

THOMASTON LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship will be awarded to a **Thomaston resident graduating from high school** who plans to further their education. The scholarship winner will be selected on the community service to school and community, financial need, and essay

Transcript, Letter of Recommendation and Essay required: "How I Can Make a Difference in the Thomaston Community".

THOMASTON ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP (Thomaston Resident *and* College students)

Scholarship money totaling \$10,000 will be awarded to **high school seniors as well as former students attending college who reside in Thomaston**. The scholarship winners will be selected on the basis of need, scholarship, and citizenship.

Transcript, Resume, and Essay required: "Share any personal information or circumstances that would lend greater insight into why you should be considered for this scholarship."

THOMASTON VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE/MYRON KLANESKI JR./ELIZABETH SHYPINKA/TERRY HAWLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship will be given to a **graduating high school senior** to provide financial assistance to further their educational pursuits beyond the high school level. Criteria include financial need and worthy vocational plans. Special consideration will be given to a student planning to enter the medical profession.

Transcript and Letter of Recommendation required.

THOMASTON VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT/LADIES AUXILIARY

This scholarship will be awarded to a **graduating high school senior** who is a Thomaston resident. Based on financial need and having a worthy vocational motive to obtain an education or skills beyond the high school level.

Transcript and Letter of Recommendation required.

THOMASTON WOMAN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

The Thomaston Woman's Club awards a scholarship annually to a **graduating high school senior** who is a Thomaston resident. The winner will be selected on the basis of scholarship, need, leadership and service to the community.

Transcript, (2) Letters of Recommendation and Essay required: "Why do you want to pursue your chosen field of study."
